WHEREAS, Jimmie Johnson's charity, The Jimmie Johnson Foundation, has raised a significant amount of money dedicated to assisting children, families and communities in need throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, The Jimmie Johnson Foundation has helped save tens of thousands of lives through blood collection and by adding individuals to the National Marrow Donor Program Registry; and

WHEREAS, Racing fans in New York are vital to NASCAR, and New York is home to Watkins Glen International, the host of one NASCAR Sprint Cup Series event annually; and

WHEREAS, His two pole position wins and many impressive top 10

finishes at Watkins Glen International have helped him build momentum leading into the final stretch of the season resulting in his five consecutive NASCAR Sprint Cup Series titles; and
