WHEREAS, There has been a dramatic increase in training, especially specialized training, at the academy due in large part to his close working relationship with the countless other agencies which utilize the facility; and

WHEREAS, He has contributed his time and expertise to a consortium involved in the establishment of a state-of-the-art facility for

firearms and other training which is soon to open in Glenville; and
WHEREAS, Pat has also worked closely with the academy's Board of Directors, overseeing several programs which often run concurrently at the academy; and

WHEREAS, He has been a tremendous asset to the academy and the countless law enforcement officials who train there; and

WHEREAS, His expertise, dedication, professionalism, and enthusiasm are an inspiration to his colleagues; now, therefore, be it
