WHEREAS, Meaningful Parent Leadership occurs when parents gain the knowledge and skills necessary to function in leadership roles and present a "parent voice" to help shape the direction of their families, programs and communities; and

WHEREAS, Parent Leadership is an essential and effective means of strengthening families and preventing child abuse and neglect; and

WHEREAS, Partnering with parents and that Parent Leadership is a necessary component in any effective family strengthening and family support program; and

WHEREAS, Parent Leadership Month recognizes the extraordinary courage and tenacity of parents who have reached out to make improvements in their families and communities; and

WHEREAS, Parent Leadership Month also recognizes peer parent support is a critical way to engage and encourage families involved with the child; and

WHEREAS, Parent Leadership Month commends, honors and celebrates parents for their vital leadership roles in their homes and communities, and in local, state and national levels; now, therefore, be it
