WHEREAS, Annette Adamczak has been a powerful voice advocating to make learning these life-saving skills part of the required curriculum in schools throughout New York State; and

WHEREAS, As a Certified CPR Instructor for Rural/Metro Medical Services, Annette Adamczak uses her personal story to connect with students, empowering them with the knowledge and skills to save a life; her vital mission began at Akron Central School where her daughter attended; and

WHEREAS, Annette Adamczak helped to make sure there were AEDs installed at the Akron Sports Complex and Newstead Veterans Park; and WHEREAS, Annette Adamczak has dedicated her life to bringing CPR training to every student in the State of New York; in addition to training and advocacy, she organizes the annual Emily Rose 5K Race in

order to raise funds to help support AED and CPR training; and WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body that individuals who exemplify a spirit of humanity, transforming personal tragedy into proactive work for the health, safety and well-being of all citizens of this great Empire State should be recognized and celebrated; now, therefore, be it
