WHEREAS, Reginald Dennis, a resident of Liverpool, New York, is now on a path to achieving personal success by meeting his goals; he received a full scholarship to attend Syracuse University through the Higher Education Opportunity Program and is presently studying Business Management; and

WHEREAS, Reginald Dennis also remains active in supporting the adult literacy programs at OCM BOCES by speaking to middle school students who are at risk of dropping out; and

WHEREAS, Reginald Dennis continues to inspire at-risk youth, and all who meet him, by demonstrating the importance of hard work and dedication; now therefore, be it
