**Regional Councils Report on Progress** 



Yesterday, Governor Cuomo hosted the state's ten regional economic development councils in Albany where they each gave presentations reporting on the <u>status</u> of their projects. All 739 of the projects that are receiving state funding are currently underway. Of those projects, 75 percent have reached their first milestone.

As Chairman of the Senate Committee on Commerce, Economic Development and Small Business, I was proud to work with Governor Cuomo and Lt. Governor Duffy last year to put forth recommendations to create the ten regional councils. Each regional council, including the <u>Finger Lakes Regional Economic Development Council</u>, will be submitting a one-year progress report to the state on September 14, 2012. This project report will highlight improvements and adjustments, in addition to outlining the councils' 2012 priority projects. Funding awards for the second round are expected to be announced this fall.

Governor Cuomo also announced new economic initiatives aimed at job creation while supporting the next round of funding, including the Connect NY Program. Please click <u>here</u> to learn more.
