Thank you for the opportunity to voice my opinion as it relates to the Scoping Plan. My name is Jackie Weisberg, and I am a member of 350Brooklyn. I am also a member of NY Renews, and have been a member since before the CLCPA was made into law.

New York Renews has written the **Climate Jobs & Justice Package** that lays out demands that are needed to implement the Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act. NYers have shown, upon voting for the \$4B bond act, that a just transition to a clean energy economy is uppermost in their concerns. The CAC's Scoping Plan includes false climate solutions, such as carbon capture and sequestration and cannot be a part of the CLCPA implementation. Furthermore, pushback against greenwashing, misinformation & obstruction campaigns need to be vigorous.

For the past three years funding and implementation planning of the CLCPA has faltered, in large part due to the bad actors in the fossil fuel industry. We have little time to meet the goals of the CLCPA; the time is now, in this session, this year. We cannot allow the CLCPA to become a paper tiger or a hollow imitation of its mandates.

NY Renews demands that new legislation to make sure that CLCPA enactment is equitable and transparent, that \$10 billion is in the 2023/2024 executive budget to kickstart Climate Act implementation. There can be no equivocating. All agencies and authorities involved must ensure effective, equitable, and clear regulatory effort to implement the CLCPA, via NY Renews Climate Jobs and Justice Package.
