I voted at the Dewitt Town Hall on an early-voting day. Upon arriving I feared that the wait to get inside would be long because of the length of the line, but I was inside within 15 or 20 minutes. The elections workers outside were helpful and skillfully directed people. The only wrinkle seemed to be a lack of signage directing people who needed special access or expedited processing because of disability or advanced age. Inside the polling place the workers were efficient and skilled in processing people. They made it easy for me.
