## Testimony: Elections and Voting Rights

- 1. My name is Suzanne Johnson. I am a resident at 14 Innisfree Place, Eastchester NY. This is my personal testimony.
- 2. We the People have no faith that our elections are free and fair.
- 3. We the People have no confidence in the integrity of our voting system.
- 4. NYS needs to **restore confidence in our election system** to remain accessible, efficient, and secure.
- 5. In-person voting should be done on one (1) day, on paper ballots with each voter showing a valid picture ID.
- 6. Signature verification done in the past into election books is not reliable source of identification. Identification can vary from driver's license, SSN card, state issued ID.
- 7. The idea that this is a discriminatory practice is absurd. Identification is required to buy alcohol and tobacco, enter a public school, drive, rent an apartment, receive federal or state aid, fly on a plane, pick up tickets to a show.
- 8. This does not make sense: NYC is now requiring vaccine papers to eat in a restaurant and go to work, but voters are not required to show identification.
- 9. NYS needs to prohibit unsolicited mass mailing of ballots and ballot harvesting.
- 10. NYS needs to **prohibit Election Supervisors from accepting private donations or grants** to fund any aspect of election administration or operations.
- 11. NYS needs to **end same day voter registration**. There is no way to verify the accuracy of voter information on the day of an election.
- 12. NYS needs to **secure voter rolls** by requiring additional identification information when changing voter registration information.
- 13. NYS needs to **increase transparency** by requiring all counties to have access to live voter turnout data and update hourly.
- 14. Election day counting of vote-by-mail ballots received and uncounted needs to be reported to the public every hour.
